

REAL COUNTY DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER
FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, REAL COUNTY on the 14th of JULY, 2025, Real County Judge issued a Declaration of Disaster due to severe flooding. And Real County has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from SEVERE FLOODING DUE TO HEAVY RAINFALL, FLASH FLOODING, and RIVER FLOODING.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY JUDGE OF REAL COUNTY has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF REAL COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for REAL COUNTY pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the COMMISSIONER'S COURT of REAL COUNTY.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the REAL COUNTY emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.

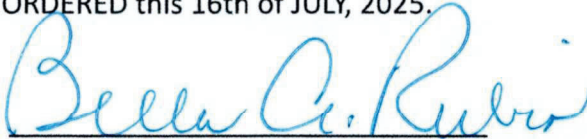
