

## DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

WHEREAS A majority of the County of Real effective July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and continuing through present time, has experienced extremely severe water shortages due to the widespread heat and dry weather conditions; and

WHEREAS Several individual and public water wells have stopped pumping water because of the lower of water tables; and

WHEREAS The City of Camp Wood Water Supply and The City of Leakey Water Supply are some of the water systems hit extremely hard as a result of the lowering of the natural water level; and

WHEREAS Weather forecast from the United States Weather Service does not indicate any immediate relief from the dry, hot weather conditions; and

WHEREAS Immediate assistance is needed to counter the on-going water shortage:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF REAL COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Real County pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to Section 418.108 (c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.108 (d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of local disaster activates the county emergency management plan.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance
5. That this declaration shall seek any and all state and federal relief available
