

Bandera, Uvalde, Medina, and Real County – Utopia/Vanderpool Area Emergency Services District No.1

ORDER ON 2023 TAX RATE

Whereas 26.05(B) of the Texas Code States "a taxing unit may not impose property taxes any year until the governing body has adopted a tax rate for that year, and annual tax rate for that year, and the annual tax rate must be set by ordinance, resolution, or order, depending on the method prescribed by law for adoption of a law by the governing body. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or other setting the tax rate must be separate from the vote adopting the budget."

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Utopia Vanderpool Emergency Services District #1 that the 2023 Tax Rate is \$.075545/\$100 valuation. The Utopia Vanderpool Emergency District #1 Commissioners officially finds, determines, and declares that this 2023 Tax Rate was reviewed, carefully considered, and adopted at meeting of the Board September 21, 2023, and that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place, and subject of this meeting was posted at a place readily accessible and convenient to the public within the District; on the Utopia Vanderpool Emergency Services District #1 website; and published in the newspaper of record for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551,TEXAS GOV'T CODE, and that the this meeting was made open to the public as required by law at all times during which this 2023 Tax Rate was discussed, considered, and acted upon. The Board further ratifies, approves, and confirms such written notice and contents and posting thereof.
